340B Purchased Drugs

- 1. 340B purchased drugs dispensed by pharmacy providers will be reimbursed at their actual acquisition cost, up to the 340B Maximum Allowable Cost (MAC) (calculated ceiling price) plus the professional dispensing fee.
 - a. Covered entities as described in section 1927 (a)(5)(B) of the Social Security Act are required to bill no more than their actual acquisition cost plus the professional dispensing fee.
 - b. Drugs acquired through the federal 340B drug pricing program and dispensed by 340B contract pharmacies are not covered, unless the State approves an exception.
- 2. Physician-administered drugs purchased through the 340B program will be reimbursed the lesser of the Physician-Administered 340B MAC or the actual acquisition cost submitted by the provider.
 - a. No professional dispensing fee will be applied to physician-administered drugs.
