Dear Kim Bimestefer,

On June 29, 2022, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) received Colorado State Plan Amendment (SPA) CO-22-0007 to implement the family planning eligibility group. The group will cover individuals with household income up to 260 percent of the federal poverty level (FPL), the state's current income standard for pregnant individuals in its Children's Health Insurance Program.

We approve Colorado State Plan Amendment (SPA) CO-22-0007 with an effective date(s) of July 01, 2022.

Since Colorado is adding the family planning group (limited eligibility group), a companion coverage SPA describing the family planning-related services covered under this group needs to be submitted. As identified in the implementation guide, benefits for individuals eligible in this group are limited to family planning services and supplies and family planning-related services, as described in the coverage section of the state's Medicaid state plan. This includes medical diagnosis and treatment services that are provided pursuant to a family planning service in a family planning setting. When a state is newly electing to cover the family planning group, it must submit a "companion" coverage state plan amendment (SPA) in addition to the eligibility SPA electing to cover this group. In the coverage SPA, the state describes the family planning-related services covered under this group.
