Dear Interim Director Halsey:

We are writing to inform you that the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is approving Connecticut's request to amend the following 1915(c) Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) waivers with the Emergency Preparedness and Response Appendix K in order to respond to the COVID-19 pandemic:

Individual and Family Support Waiver	CT.0426.R03.11
Employment and Day Supports Waiver	CT.0881.R02.04

The state's approved Appendix K is effective March 16, 2020 through six months after the end of the federal public health emergency (PHE) for COVID-19. The amendments that the state has requested in the Appendix K are additive to those previously approved; they apply in all locations served by the individual waivers for anyone impacted by COVID-19. Effective February 1, 2023, the state is amending how funds from section 9817 of the American Rescue Plan (ARP) are issued for incentive-based outcome payments and enhanced rate increases for the identified providers and services within the Appendix K.

The state has identified its intent to use money realized from section 9817 of the ARP. Approval of this action does not constitute approval of the state's spending plan. The state must have an approved spending plan in order to use the money realized from section 9817 of the ARP.

We have included the approved Appendix K pages with this correspondence. Please utilize the waiver management system for HCBS waivers for any further amendments to these waiver programs other than the Appendix K.
