

### **Medicaid IAP**

- Commitment by CMS to build state capacity and support ongoing innovation in Medicaid through targeted technical assistance
- A Center for Medicare & Medicaid Innovation funded initiative that is led by Center for Medicaid and CHIP Services
- Program that supports delivery system reform efforts
- Not a grant program; targeted technical assistance

- Support states as they develop program, payment, and system interventions to reduce SUD
- Provide technical assistance to states to improve the care and outcomes for individuals with an SUD
- Assist states with their strategies to address the opioid crisis




### **IAP SUD: Types of Technical Assistance**

- One-on-one technical assistance, learning opportunities, and resources for SUD delivery system reform for Medicaid agencies
- Multi-tiered approach
  - Collaborative learning opportunities
  - Tools and resources
  - National dissemination and learning opportunities
  - Subject matter expert (SME) support

## **Data Dashboard Affinity Group**

### **Data Dashboard Affinity Group**

- Provide Medicaid agencies with technical assistance to produce new or revise existing SUD data dashboards
- Learn about best practices in dashboard design
- February 2020–August 2020



## Data Dashboard Affinity Group Technical Assistance

- One-on-one coaching
  - Coaching sessions will be held every other week with the IAP state support team
- Group technical assistance webinars
  - Two webinars with presentations highlighting best practices in data visualization and dashboard creation



# Data Dashboard Affinity Group Technical Assistance (Cont'd.)

#### Group coaching calls

 Two calls with coaches and peer states to discuss lessons learned in group webinars as well as to share successes and barriers in their dashboard development.

#### Group update webinar

 One update webinar between the group coaching calls for teams to share updates on dashboard development with peer states.

## **MAT Affinity Group**

### **MAT Affinity Group**

- Opportunity for Medicaid agencies to identify strategies for modernizing their MAT delivery systems across a series of related topics
- Comprised of three, eight-week-long components running sequentially for seven months from February 2020 through August 2020
  - States can participate in one, two, or all three components
- Includes the development of one or more strategic work plan(s)



# Component 1: Role of Opioid Treatment Programs

- Assist states in—
  - Better understanding the role and functions of opioid treatment programs (OTPs)
  - Assessing the feasibility of transforming OTPs into health homes or centers of excellence
  - Considering value-based payment strategies and new reimbursement models
- February 2020–April 2020



# Component 2: Key MAT Strategies to Enhance Access

- Assist states in—
  - Understanding how to conduct high-level reviews of the state's programs and payment arrangements for MAT
  - Considering the impact of MAT on access
- April 2020–June 2020



# Component 3: Identifying and Using Performance Metrics

- Assist states in
  - Identifying existing measures for assessing MAT access, quality, and outcomes
  - Considering system- and patient-level indicators of quality care
  - Recognizing state capacity for measurement
- June 2020–August 2020



## **MAT Affinity Group Technical Assistance**

- Group coaching calls
  - Alternating every other week with SMEs and peer states
- Webinars
  - Two webinars per component
    - **Kickoff webinar**: Presentation by an SME or representative from example state Medicaid program on the specific MAT component
    - Closeout webinar: State Affinity Group teams present work plan
- Office hours calls
  - Optional group calls with component coaches, offered every other week, alternating with the group coaching meetings

- State Medicaid Program lead
- Medicaid policy and program experts
- Medicaid staff member with clinical expertise in MAT
- Single State Agency for Substance Abuse Services policy and program experts (if possible)
