



## Medicaid Health Home State Profile: Connecticut

As of March 2026, Connecticut operates **one** health home model for **serious mental illness (SMI)**.

### **SMI Model**

**Start Date:** 10/1/15

**Targeted Conditions:** SMI including schizophrenia and psychotic disorders, mood disorders, anxiety disorders, obsessive compulsive disorder, post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD), and/or borderline personality disorder

**Eligibility:** Must have an SMI diagnosis

**Key Providers:** Local Mental Health Authorities (LMHA) and designated LMHA affiliates

**Enrollment:** Opt-in enrollment

**Geography:** Statewide

**Payment:** Fee-for-service (FFS) per member per month (PMPM)
