



## Medicaid Health Home State Profile: Idaho

As of March 2026, Idaho operates **one** health home model for **intellectual/developmental disabilities (I/DD)**.

Idaho previously operated a chronic conditions and serious mental illness (SMI) model, which was terminated in 2016. For additional details on this terminated program, refer to the Health Homes Overview document.

### **I/DD Model**

**Start Date:** 1/1/24

**Targeted Conditions:** I/DD

**Eligibility:** Must have an intellectual disability and a mental health diagnosis of SMI or autism, where acuity exceeds the existing level of traditional community services and health and safety needs cannot be met through traditional community services (i.e., need for more specialized care plan)

**Key Providers:** Health Home Team: Intellectual Disability/Mental Illness (ID/MI) Health Home

**Enrollment:** Referral and assignment to Health Home provider with opt-out

**Geography:** Statewide

**Payment:** Fee-for-service (FFS), comprehensive methodology included in state plan amendment
