As of March 2026, Missouri operates **three** health home models:

- [Serious Mental Illness \(SMI\) and Substance Use Disorder \(SUD\)/Mental Health \(MH\)](#)

Chronic Conditions Model

Start Date: 1/1/12

Targeted Conditions: asthma, diabetes, heart disease, BMI over 25, tobacco use, developmental disabilities, mental health conditions, SUD, chronic pain

Eligibility: Individuals with two chronic conditions; or, one chronic conditions and at risk of developing another (at risk criteria include tobacco use or diabetes)

Key Providers: Designated providers of health home services will be Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs), Rural Health Centers (RHCs), and primary care clinics operated by hospitals

Enrollment: Opt-out

Geography: Statewide

Payment: PMPM

I/DD Model

Start Date: 7/1/24

Targeted Conditions: Asthma, diabetes, heart disease, BMI greater than 25, cerebrovascular disease, chronic obstructed pulmonary disease (COPD), hypertension, I/DD, dementia, ventilator dependency, one of the Fatal Five Plus conditions or one or more chronic conditions that could lead to one of the Fatal Five Plus conditions: pulmonary aspiration, bowel obstruction, gastroesophageal reflux disease, seizures, sepsis, dehydration, tobacco use, diagnosis of autism spectrum disorder, or using the Health Risk Screening Tool that identifies potential risk for individuals with a Healthcare Level of 3 or greater

Eligibility: Individuals served through the Missouri Department of Mental Health, Division of Developmental Disabilities (DD), who have a chronic condition of I/DD and have or are at risk for developing another qualifying chronic health condition, have or are at risk for developing another condition

Key Providers: DD Targeted Case Management and/or DD Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) certified or accredited waiver providers

Enrollment: Opt-out

Geography: Statewide

Payment: PMPM, case rate basis

MO-24-0005	Approved: 4/29/24 Effective: 7/1/24	Creates a statewide DD Health Home for individuals served through the Missouri Department of Mental Health, Division of DD, who have a qualifying chronic health condition, have or are at risk of developing another condition, and are eligible for Division of DD services



SMI and SUD/MH Model

Start Date: 1/1/12

Targeted Conditions: SMI, mental health conditions, SUD, asthma, diabetes, heart disease, BMI greater than 25, I/DD, tobacco use, COPD

Eligibility: Individuals with SMI only; mental health or SUD plus a chronic condition; or mental health or SUD plus tobacco use

Key Providers: CMHC meeting state qualifications

Enrollment: Opt-out

Geography: Statewide

Payment: PMPM

MO-19-0017	Approved: 11/13/19 Effective: 7/1/19	Adds a 1.5% rate increase to PMPM for CMHC Health Homes
