



Medicaid Health Home State Profile: New Mexico

As of March 2026, New Mexico operates **one** health home model for **serious mental illness (SMI)/serious emotional disturbance (SED)**.

SMI/SED Model

Start Date: 4/1/2016

Targeted Conditions: SMI/SED, OUD, SUD

Eligibility: Adults with SMI and children with SED, individuals with OUD or another SUD and another chronic condition(s)

Key Providers: Clinical practices or clinical group practices, Rural Health Clinics, community/behavioral health agencies including Core Services Agencies, Federally Qualified Health Centers, and Indian Health Services clinics

Enrollment: Opt-out

Geography: 10 counties (Bernalillo, Curry, De Baca, Grant, Hidalgo, Lea, Quay, Roosevelt, San Juan, Sandoval)

Payment: Fee-for-service (FFS) per member, per month (PMPM)

NM-15-0014	Approved: 3/21/16 Effective: 4/1/16	Creates Behavioral Health Homes (BHHs) in two counties
NM-18-0002	Approved: 7/3/18 Effective: 4/1/18	Expands BHHs to eight additional counties with seven providers, one of which will be a Tribal Health Home. Will also pilot a high-fidelity wraparound (HFW) model with two providers for children/adolescents
NM-21-0005	Approved: 4/15/21 Effective: 1/1/21	Adds SUD as an additional eligibility criterion for health home services
NM-23-0008	Approved: 8/15/23 Effective: 6/30/23	Removes the HFW language from the health home SPA since it will now be a part of a new 1115 demonstration to prevent duplication of services
