



Medicaid Health Home State Profile: South Dakota

As of March 2026, South Dakota operates **one** health home model for **chronic conditions and serious mental illness (SMI)**.

Chronic Conditions and SMI Model

Start Date: 7/2/13

Targeted Conditions: SMI, mental health conditions, substance use disorder, asthma, diabetes, heart disease, body mass index greater than 25, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, hypertension, musculoskeletal and neck and back disorders

Eligibility: Individuals with two or more chronic conditions; one chronic condition and the risk of developing a second; or one SMI

Key Providers: Designated providers, including physicians, Rural Health Clinics, Community Health Clinics, Community Mental Health Clinics, Federally Qualified Health Centers, advanced practice nurses, and physician assistants

Enrollment: Opt-in

Geography: Statewide

Payment: Tiered per member, per month
